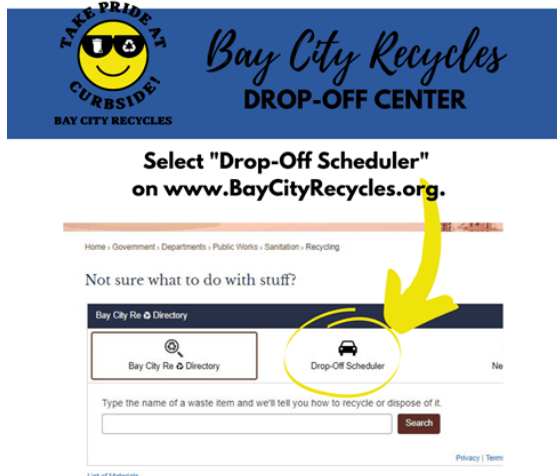
Please also help us welcome three (3) new Refuse Collection Workers:
