Green Meters available to customers taking advantage of the Electric Utility's Renewable Energy Program

The Electric Metering Department has received the new "green meters". The green meters will be used for customers taking advantage of our renewable energy program.

Here's some general information about the Green Meters

The green label aids field crews to quickly identify the type of service.

All solar builds by design have a built in disconnect. The green meter has an added safeguard to remotely disconnect the service in the field during an outage to keep the unit from feeding on to a service line that crews may be working on.

Pole replacement work stalled by high winds

It was quite windy on Thursday, March 18th, so the replacement of a pole took a bit longer than usual. Bay City Electric Light & Power customers around South Mackinaw Road and E. North Union Road were impacted by an outage for a pole replacement.

A typical replacement takes about three hours under blue sky conditions. This replacement took about five hours.
