2021 Employee of the Year

The Department was assessed by individuals appointed by the Michigan Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission. "He runs our Support Operations Division which handles the Detective Bureau, all of our property and evidence, and clerical, crime analysis, and video analysis. He's a very intelligent man.
