The discussion centered on the failing infrastructure of both Independence (service year 1973) and Liberty (service year 1984) bridges. The structures have exceeded their lifespan and continued repair is not cost effective.

Toll Bridge by Privatization

The course of action determined by the group was as follows:

- Retain Bond Counsel to seek ways to lawfully fund the replacement of the bridges
- Engage other community stakeholders to assist in the process
 Potential partners include local Townships, County Road Commission, MDOT Officials,
 State and Federal Representatives, Bay Area Chamber and Great Lakes Bay Region
 Alliance.





• Develop and Provide an Education Plan for Bay City / County Residents for informed decision making based on potential funding.

All participants agreed that the next course of action would be to open the discussion to include interested members of the public and key stakeholders. Therefore a joint meeting of the City and County Officials will be held on February 5, 2018 – 10:00 am at the Doubletree Hotel Conference Center.
