**BOND REQUIREMENTS FOR
VENDORS AND PEDDLERS**

Each peddler or vendor licensee shall deposit with the City Clerk a surety bond in the amount of three (3) times the highest priced item being sold or \$1,000, whichever is highest. Such surety bond shall be conditioned for the faithful performance of the licensee's promises and contracts made during the course of business as a peddler or vendor within the City of Bay City for compliance with all of the Ordinances of the City of Bay City and laws of the State of Michigan. Such bond shall provide that any person injured by the breach of any obligation for which the bond is given to secure may sue upon such bond in his own name in any court of competent jurisdiction to recover any damages such person may have sustained by such breach. Such bond shall be for a period of not less than six (6) months.
